## Nomination Categories

### **The Champion Award**

*A person who has made an outstanding contribution to the community advocating for the rights and well-being of people with disability*

Criteria:

1. The nominee has lived experience of disability.
2. The nominee has made a significant contribution to the Darwin community, which has resulted in improved conditions, services, well-being, or understanding of individuals or groups of people with disability.
3. The nominee has a record of being a champion for the rights of people with disability.

### **The Rising Star Award**

*A person under 25 who makes an ongoing contribution to their school, workplace or community advocating for the rights and well-being of people with disability*

Criteria:

1. The nominee is under 25 years old with lived experience of disability.
2. The nominee makes an ongoing contribution to their school, workplace or community.
3. The nominee advocates for the rights and well-being of people with disability.
