Let's Cook and Create - Cultural Cooking and Sharing

This program centres on cultural cooking and sharing, where interested women convene every other Tuesday to showcase the preparation of their cultural dishes to fellow participants.

Let's Engage and Create - Capacity Building Workshops

These workshops are dedicated to personal and leadership development, led by women from migrant communities who have become Red Cross volunteers. The workshops promote cultural and skills exchange, authentic leadership, and advocacy.

Designed for recent migrants, asylum seekers, refugees, and Australian women from diverse cultures seeking to enhance their native spoken English skills while forming new friendships.

These events serve as platforms to showcase the talents of participating women and women from multicultural communities in the NT.

The food trailer project fosters a collaborative environment where women from diverse backgrounds can come together, share their unique cultures and experiences in a safe, respectful, and supportive setting. With the Companion Card, your companion or carer can accompany you to participating recreational and entertainment venues and events without having to pay for their ticket.

This program operates in every state across Australia, making it available for use when traveling outside of your home state.

The Companion Card Program aims to:

- Support the right of individuals with disabilities to fair ticketing
- Help organizations comply with existing legislation
- Provide a simple and consistent way to recognize those in need of attendant care support to participate in recreational activities and venues.
