The NDIS takes a lifetime approach, investing early in people with disability and children with developmental delays to improve their outcomes later in life. The NDIS also connects anyone with a disability to services and supports state and territory governments offer.

NDIS QUALITY & SAFEGUARDS COMMISSION

The NDIS Commission:

- Responds to concerns, complaints and reportable incidents, including abuse and neglect of NDIS participants
- Promotes the NDIS principles of choice and control, and works to empower participants to exercise their rights to access quality services as informed, protected consumers
- Provides guidance and best practice information to NDIS providers on how to comply with their registration responsibilities
- Monitors compliance against the NDIS Code of Conduct and NDIS Practice Standards, including undertaking investigations and taking enforcement action

These events serve as platforms to showcase the talents of participating women and women from multicultural communities in the NT.

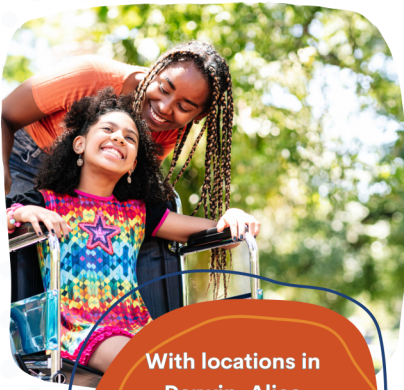

Have you heard of the Companion Card? If you require lifelong attendant care support to engage with the community due to a disability, you may qualify for one in the Northern Territory (NT).

With the Companion Card, your companion or carer can accompany you to participating recreational and entertainment venues and events without paying for their ticket.

This program operates in every state across Australia, making it available for use when travelling outside of your home state.

The Companion Card Program aims to:

- Support the right of individuals with disabilities to fair ticketing
- Help organisations comply with existing legislation
- Provide a simple and consistent way to recognise those needing attendant care support to participate in recreational activities and venues.
