Student Wellbeing and Inclusion Programs and Services (SWIPS) delivers services to government schools when wellbeing or inclusion challenges are affecting students' learning and access to education.

SWIPS services are delivered by professionals including specialist teachers, occupational therapists, speech therapists, psychologists and social workers. Schools can request SWIPS services for students with disability and other wellbeing needs. If you have concerns about your child's learning, talk to their teacher. With your consent, the school may request a service from SWIPS.


SWIPS also run a Student Advocacy Program, which supports parents of children with disability to understand their rights and the education options available to them.

The Student Advocacy Program is delivered by 54 Reasons and Integrated disability Action.

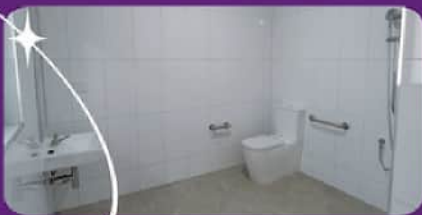
